Williams County Real Estate Tax Statements to be Mailed

Williston, N.D., (Dec. 12, 2014) – On Friday, December 12 Williams County mailed out the 2014 real estate property tax statements. Williams County taxpayers should pay close attention to their mail and expect their tax statements on pink paper. Due to a statewide effort to standardize the format of tax statements this year's statement may look different than statements received in the past, however the content has not changed. Online statements are available at www.williamsnd.com under "property taxes."

IMPORTANT: Property owners in Grenora School District #99 will receive **two** statements, the pink original and a **corrected** white statement. Please disregard the pink statement and pay from the white statement.

Property taxes can be paid online by credit card, in person by credit card/cash/check, and through the mail by cash/check. Please note a 2.45% convenience fee for credit card payments.

Williams County taxpayers can benefit from a 5 percent discount on their taxes if they pay their taxes in full by February 17, 2015. Taxes become delinquent if the first half is not paid by March 2. The second half of taxes must be paid by October 15.

Williams County requests that those tax payers with escrow accounts please contact their mortgage company to see if they will be paying on the taxpayer's behalf. Tax payers will receive a tax statement regardless.
